The first collection for our Hope Clinic Summer 2023 Drive was completed on Sunday, May 28. The Hope Anchor Team and Hope Clinic thank you for your faithful generosity!!

Our focus for May was non-food groceries and we were not disappointed! Between folks who delivered directly to Hope, ordered from Amazon, and brought their gifts to church, we received a variety of household items including zip lock bags, aluminum foil, cleaning products, paper products (including 62 rolls of TP, wipes, paper towels and tissues), and a generous supply of laundry detergent (17 jugs and 84 pods!). You also donated sunscreen, deodorant, hair care products and a collection of personal-size dental products. Two kind souls ordered art supplies for Hope's clients to use in their annual client art show! And, finally, anticipating June's focus, we received 6 packages of baby wipes and 284 diapers. Always appreciated!

We will continue our support of Hope Clinic in June with a focus on baby care items. According to Hope's website, their greatest need is for size 5 and 6 diapers and pull ups or water diapers for swimming season. They could also use formula - Costco, Meijer and Sam's Club brands are preferred – they already have a good supply of Enfamil), and baby thermometers.

Just so you know, we will be focusing on kid-friendly foods in July and they are always welcome as many kids lose access to in-school meal programs over the summer.
