**YOU GAVE ME CLOTHING:** You can purchase underwear, socks, and other items through our <u>Amazon Wish List.</u> Simply choose the items you would like to purchase and when prompted to choose the shipping address, click "First Baptist Church's Gift Registry Address." Items will be shipped directly to church.


